Introduction

The 6-Way Diverting Valve Panel receives flow from an air-to-water or water-to-water heat pump and directs the flow in a 4-pipe hydronic heating and cooling system to either the hot or cold buffer tanks. The panel is normally heating and changes to cooling operation when a cooling signal is received.

Installation

Tools Required

- Two pipe wrenches
- Philips screwdriver

Materials Required


- Male NPT adapter or threaded nipple
- Teflon tape
- Pipe thread sealant
- 24 V(ac), 30 VA or greater transformer

Piping

Install pipe adapters or threaded nipples to each valve port. Use pipe clamps to mount the panel to slotted steel strut channels. Use wood or masonry screws to fasten the assembly to a supporting wall. Alternatively, pipe hangers may be installed to provide support from a ceiling.

Factory Default Valve Positions

The panel ships from the factory with the following valve port configuration.



Field Reversed Valve Positions


The valve may be piped in the following reversed valve positions.

If field reversing the ports:

- Reverse the Molex plugs as described in the electrical section.
- Remove the factory default valve position labels A1 and A2 and replace with the field reversed valve position labels A1 and A2.

NOTICE

The middle port of each 3-way valve must be piped to the heat pump. This cannot be changed.




Wiring Schematic

This section provides a wiring schematic for the control.

A WARNING

- Before wiring, ensure all power is turned off and take all necessary precautions.
- Strip all wiring to a length of % in. or 10 mm for all terminals.
- A circuit breaker or power disconnect that provides power to the control should be located nearby and clearly labeled.
- Refer to the current and voltage ratings at the back of this brochure before connecting devices to this control.
- Only qualified personnel should install or service the control.



Wiring Instructions

This section explains how to wire the diverting valve panel to control.

Cool Call

- Connect the cool call terminals to the diverting valve terminals on the system control.
- When open the diverting valve panel is in heating mode.
- When closed the diverting valve panel is in cooling mode.

Input Power (R & C)

A 24 V(ac), 30 VA, Class 2 transformer is required.

- Connect the power supply R
- Connect the C to the power source common C

Factory Default Valve Position

- Leave Actuator 1 Molex connector connected to Actuator 1 socket
- Leave Actuator 2 Molex connector connected to Actuator 2 socket

Field Reverse Valve Position


- Unplug Actuator 1 and 2 Molex connectors from their respective sockets
- Plug Actuator 1 Molex connector to Actuator 2 socket
- Plug Actuator 2 Molex connector to Actuator 1 socket
- Remove the factory default valve position labels A1 and A2 and replace with the field reversed valve position labels A1 and A2.

Testing and Troubleshooting

Manual Override

The actuator motors include a manual override:

- 1. Turn the knob to position MAN (counter-clockwise) and hold it in position.
- 2. Turn the outgoing drive shaft of the actuator with the help of an adjustable wrench.
- 3. To re-engage automatic operation, release the knob (spring return).



Note: The valve may be stiff when first installed or after an extended period of non operation. Power cycle the valve to loosen to be able to move the valve position manually.

Sequence of Operation

The diverting valve panel is factory shipped in normally heating operation. When the cool call is shorted together, the actuators rotate 90 degrees for cooling operation.



Limited Warranty The liability of tekmar under this warranty is limited. The Purchaser, by taking receipt of any tekmar product ("Product"), acknowledges the terms of the Limited Warranty in effect at the time of such Product sale & acknowledges that it has read & understands same.

The tekmar Limited Warranty to the Purchaser on the Products sold hereunder is a manufacturer's pass-through warranty which the Purchaser is authorized to pass through to its customers.
